Thank you for purchasing the Beck Shoe Polisher<sup>TM</sup>. We are confident that you will enjoy your polisher for years to come.

We recommend you use your polisher daily to remove dust and scuff murks from your shoes and extend the life of your polish.

We do not recommend applying polish to the lambswool brushes. The polish will "mat" the brushes and shorten the life of the brush.

Many people ask "Why the two colors—what's the difference?". Well, there is absolutely no difference in the two colors. The brushes are made from 100% pure lamb's wool hides. The die is applied during processing and the colors are chosen for purely aesthetic reasons. They contain no special polishing chemicals.

We recommend you reserve the black brush for black shoes and the alternate color for other shoes. The brushes may pick up polish from your shoes during buffing and this will avoid "polish transfer" to your lighter colored shoes.

Many customers purchase one of each available color and designate them to specific colors of shoes. The choice is purely up to you. To purchase additional brushes contact our Customer Service line at 1-800-283-3306.

The available colors are:


Black, Burgundy, Dark Brown, Silver Gray and Charcoal Gray. For instructions on changing the brushes see illustration on reverse side.

### Beck Shoe Polisher™ Instruction Sheet



### To Replace Brushes

Unplug unit from wall and move to a well lighted area. Gently pull brush away from body of unit until elastic is visible. Using short arm of hex wrench slide elastic up over the edge of the cone. Slide on new brush and slip elastic back over cone edge until it is secure. Test by turning on unit to be sure brush is secure and no slippage occurs before using.

### To Replace Cones

Unplug unit from wall and move to a well lighted Remove brushes by following above directions. Turn cone while looking between cone and housing until lock screw 3 is visible on the Brush Spindle 4. Slide Hex Wrench 2 down along the side of the housing 5 into the lock screw. Loosen by turning counter-clockwise. Slide off old cone and replace with new cone. Place hex wrench into lock screw on new cone and slide cone on to motor shaft ① until the Hex Wrench touches side of housing. (CAUTION: Sliding cone too far on to shaft can cause damage to motor) Tighten securely. Rattle will occur if not properly tightened or aligned. If necessary repeat procedure to ensure it is properly installed. Replace brush following above instructions.

### Consumer Cautions - Please Read Carefully!

Before connecting the shoe polisher to a power source (receptacle, outlet, etc.) be sure the voltage supplied is the same as that specified on the UL Label of the polisher. A power source greater than that specified for the polisher can result in **serious injury** to user as well as damage to the polisher. If in doubt as to voltage, **DO NOT PLUG IN THE POLISHER!** Using a power source with insufficient voltage is harmful to the motor.

To prevent personal injury, always disconnect the polisher from power source before cleaning, moving, or changing the buffer brushes. Keep fingers and jewelry away from spinning brushes!

Do not alter or misuse the Beck Shoe Polisher. These polishers are precision built and any alterations or modifications constitute misuse which voids Warranty coverage and may result in **serious injury** to the user.

Grasp **PLUG** firmly between fingers to remove from outlet. Do Not pull from outlet by cord or carry or pull polisher by cord.

Avoid placing polisher in areas containing gaseous or explosive atmospheres. Motors in the polisher emit sparks which could ignite fumes.

Avoid placing polisher in damp or wet locations. Do not use polisher on wet shoes or while hands are wet as electric shock may occur.

Avoid placing polisher near items which could become entangled in the rotating brushes (eg. draperies, other electrical cords, loose clothing)

Do not allow children to play with the polisher. It is not a toy and **serious injury** could occur.

Do not attempt repairs on unit yourself.
